INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION BY NAAC



NAAC peer team visit in 2nd cycle



The College has been accredited by NAAC thrice s far. In 2004, a peer team from NAAC assessed the college and gave it C+ Grade. In September 2015 a NAAC peer team visited the College again and gave it a B grade with a score of 2.43 on a 4 points scale. The Peer Team praises the college ongoing effort to provide high quality education and focus on student overall development. In the month of April 2023, the college has been accredited by NAAC for the third time and able to achieve 'A' grade with 3.04 point on a 4 point Scale.

COLLEGE PROFILE

Saraighat College is one of the premier Higher Educational Institutions in greater Changsari area of Kamrup (Rural) District, Assam. Situated near the National Highway (NH-31), the college is well connected with other major parts of the region. Since its inception, the college has been working with a missionary zeal to promote higher education amongst the rural population of the area with special emphasis on the socio-economically marginalized sections of the society. In its relentless service, the institution has so far experienced various hazards and challenges but has successfully managed to overcome them.

Established on 21st July, 1981 with 116 students, 8 teachers and 2 non-teaching staff, Saraighat College is currently providing higher education to nearly 1600 students with strength of 30 permanent faculties and 10 non-teaching staff. The institution was brought under the 'deficit Grant-in-Aid' system and the 'Government Provincialized' status under the Assam State Government on 25th March 1998 and 1st January 2006 respectively. It was placed under the 2(f) Category on 28-10-2008 and 12-B Category on 13-4-2019 by the University Grants Commission (UGC)., The College offers Higher Secondary course under the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) and Bachelor of Arts courses (Honours & Regular) across 11 disciplines affiliated to Gauhati University (G.U.). From 2016 onwards, the College has also started a three years Vocational course in Travel and Tourism Management (B.Voc under G.U.). From the academic session 2023-24, the college has started FYUGP courses based on NEP 2020, under Gauhati University.

Subjects for FYUGP B.A. Arts

[Under Graduate (UG) Degree Programme]

From the academic session 2023-24, the college has started FYUGP courses based on NEP 2020, under Gauhati University.

Course structure in four year under graduate programme (FYUGP) under NEP

The Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) of Gauhati University is as per UGC the Curricular Framework, published in November 2022. The course structure of FYUGP is built Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS). Under the NEP's FYUGP, it is a 4-year degree programme with the provision of multiple exits and entries, leading to the award of certificate, diploma or a degree. In FYUGP, we get a Bachelor's Degree with Major after 3 years and a degree with Major & Honours after 4 year.

The FYUGP at GU is designed to offer two types of Bachelor's Degrees to the students at the end of the successful completion of the programme - (i) Bachelor's Degree Stream and (ii) Bachelor's Degree in a Discipline. The FYUGP is divided into two parts - (i) Core Courses and (ii) Commons Courses. The minimum credit allocation for a 3-year programme is 84 credits in Core Courses and 36 credits in Common Courses, which comes to a total of minimum 120 credits for a 3-year programme. With the fourth year, the minimum credit requirements become 1660. A student can however earn up to a maximum of 132 credits in a 3-year programme and 176 by the fourth year

The Core Courses determine the ultimate degree, diploma, or certificate a student will earn at the end of third for fourth) year, second year, or first year, respectively. The performance in the Core Comes will also determine the grade of the student in the final examinations. Total minimum credit requirement is 84 for the core courses, which translates to 21 courses (i.e. papers) with a credit allocation of 4 per course (paper). A student will need to study at least two Core subjects.

Major and Minors

In case of a Bachelor's Degree in a Stream, a student either chooses a Major and Minor or just two Minors from among the subjects. In any case, a student needs to complete 21 courses or 84 credits by the third year. A Major course must carry a minimum credit of 60 and a Minor course should carry a minimum credit of 12. Usually, for majority of the students, the Core Course will consist of one Major and one Minor.

General information to Students

FYUGP (NEP) in Undergraduate Courses under Gauhati University:

The Gauhati University has introduced FYUGP (NEP) system in UG courses with effect from the academic session 2023-24. There are six semesters in UG courses over a period of three calendar years. The schedule for the semester system is as follows:

1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th Semester (including examination) : August to December

2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th Semester (including examination): January to June

A student's performance in the FYUGP semester system shall be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment in both theory and practical papers. Evaluation in each theory and practical paper will be as follows:

Internal evaluation : 40% marks (includes sessional examinations)

External evaluation: 60% marks

Internal evaluation shall be based on sessional examinations, home assignments, seminars and class attendance etc. in each semester while external evaluation shall be through a final examination at the end of the semester conducted by Gauhati University. Students must secure pass marks in both internal and external examinations separately. Students must have minimum 75% class attendance for appearing the examination.



Students' Code of Conduct

1. The College Authority issues a Non Transferable Identity Card to each student. The Card containing the photograph of its holder must be enclosed by the Principal. Saraighat College. No student may be allowed to attend classes without this Identity Card. A student must produce the same whenever the authority wants to see it.
2. The College authority does not allow the students to enter in its premises without the prescribed college-uniforms. **For boys, it is Black long trouser and Sky-Blue Shirt.** Likewise, **for the girls, it is Sky Blue Churider (Long Top); Black Long Pajama and a Churni of same colour.** Students are expected to wear shoes instead of slippers for their proper maintenance of Dress-code.
3. Students must be regular and punctual in attending classes. It is to be noted that at least 75% attendance is necessary for appearing in Council and University Examinations.
4. Smoking and chewing of tobacco is strictly prohibited inside the college campus.
5. Ragging in any form inside the college and hostel campus is strictly prohibited. Students involved in this act will be punished severely as per the directives of the Honorable Supreme Court.
6. Cleanliness should be maintained at all cost. Waste materials should be disposed off in the waste bins kept for the purpose. Writing and sticking of bills on walls and spitting on walls are strictly prohibited.
7. All students should read the notice in the notice board and visit the website regularly.

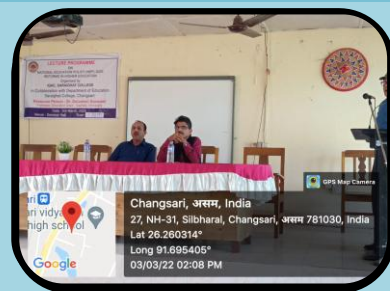
Awareness Program on “Mental Health”

MoU with USTM, Meghalaya & 8 Neighboring School located in Changsari.

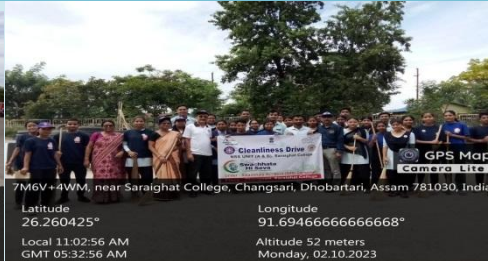
